

Long Term Care

Good Samaritan Clearwater Centre provides 30 long term care rooms, each with a private bathroom and wheelchair accessible shower. The Good Samaritan Society will provide a hospital style bed, night table, dresser and side chair. Residents are encouraged to bring some of their own belongings such as a chair, lamp, pictures, quilt or bedspread, to personalize their room. Admission is coordinated through Alberta Health Services Home Care at 403-845-3009.

Dementia Cottage

The dementia care cottage is a unique duplex designed to create a homelike setting for the needs of residents with dementia. Each side of the cottage consists of 5 bedrooms, a living room with a fireplace, kitchen, and access to a secure fenced yard. The quiet and homelike setting provides a calm environment specially suited for people with dementia. Residents are included in the activities of daily living as they are accustomed and able. Recreation and leisure activities tailored to the needs of each resident are provided within this secure unit. There is also a secure, fenced yard to enjoy when weather permits. Admission is coordinated through Alberta Health Services Home Care at 403-845-3009.

Supportive Living

The Supportive Living program at Good Samaritan Clearwater Centre consists of 29 suites: 6 one-bedroom suites, 4 two-bedroom suites and 19 studio suites. The program offers residents the flexibility to prepare their own breakfast and lunch in their suite, if they choose. Residents pay rent, which includes their supper meal, housekeeping, and linen change service. Optional services include breakfast and lunch prepared in the dining room, personal laundry service and cable television. Admission is coordinated through Alberta Health Services Home Care at 403-845-3009.

Supportive Living Dementia Cottage

This newly opened and spaciously designed Supportive Living dementia cottage consists of 10 bedrooms, dining and living areas with television viewing and a fireplace. Clients are served hot breakfast, lunch, and dinners in a homelike, family style environment. The quiet and homelike setting provides a calm environment specially suited for people with dementia. Residents are included in the activities of daily living as they are accustomed and able. Recreation and leisure activities tailored to the needs of each resident are provided within this secure unit. There is also a secure, fenced yard to enjoy when weather permits. Admission is coordinated through Alberta Health Services Home Care at 403-845-3009.
