Good Samaritan Dr. Gerald Zetter Care Centre is a unique community offering seniors multiple levels of care and support.

### Long Term Care

Good Samaritan Dr. Gerald Zetter Care Centre includes 190 long term care beds. A hospital style bed, night table and dresser will be provided. Residents are encouraged to bring some of their own belongings such as a chair, pictures, quilt or bedspread to personalize their room.

### Vacation/Respite Beds

There are two designated vacation/respice beds available for short term admission. These beds are designed for those that are normally cared for at home, allowing their caregiver a rest or vacation for a short period of time.

### Tracheostomy Care

The 8 designated Tracheostomy beds are designed to care for those individuals with high complex care needs requiring assistance of an artificial airway for breathing.



### Admission

All admissions are coordinated through Alberta Health Services (AHS). To qualify for admission residents are first assessed by AHS. Contact AHS at 780-496-1300 for information.

### Pre-Admission Visits

We encourage all prospective residents and their immediate family members to visit Good Samaritan Dr. Gerald Zetter Care Centre prior to admission. The visit allows for an exchange of information and discussions regarding expectations on the part of the resident, family and the staff at the care home.
