The Good Samaritan Society (GSS) and Good Samaritan Canada (GSC) are leading faith-based, not-for-profit, registered charities in Western Canada that provide quality accommodations, health, and community care services and programs.

Our organization has developed and implemented innovations in care and housing and provides support and services to help all residents feel at home and become an integral part of the local neighbourhood.

The entire community benefits from the unique contributions and interests of those who reside, work, volunteer, and visit the building. Together, our goal is to create a friendly, home-like community.



Assisted Living

The assisted living program at Good Samaritan Victoria Heights is intended for seniors who can no longer live independently in the community.

Good Samaritan Victoria Heights consists of 59 one-bedroom suites. Each suite is approximately 550 square feet and fully wheelchair accessible. All suites include a spacious kitchen with an apartment size stove and refrigerator, a three-piece bathroom, and ample storage.

Residents have the flexibility to prepare breakfast in their own suite, if they choose. Residents pay rent, which includes two meals per day, housekeeping, linen service and TeleCare® (an emergency response service). Residents furnish and personalize their suite with their own belongings. Optional services include breakfast, personal laundry service and cable.



Admission to Assisted Living

Good Samaritan Canada operates 57 suites funded by Fraser Health. To qualify for admission to the funded assisted living program, an assessment must be conducted to determine if individuals are eligible candidates. Application and assessment for admission is coordinated through Fraser Health Authority 604-918-7447 or contact your Case Manager if you already have home support in place. Good Samaritan Canada also operates two private pay assisted living suites at Good Samaritan Victoria Heights. For more information please contact the Assisted Living Coordinator at 604-523-9227

Pre-Admission Visits

Once assessed as requiring a supportive living level of care, we encourage all prospective residents and their immediate family members to visit Good Samaritan Victoria Heights prior to admission. The visit allows for an exchange of information and discussions regarding expectations on the part of the resident, family and the staff at the care home.
