Supportive Living

Good Samaritan Park Meadows Village consists of a total of 121 Supportive Living units, 45 of these units (41 studio and 4 one-bedroom suites) are housed in the main building and 76 units are divided into seven Dementia Care Cottages.

The program offers residents 24-hour on-site personal care with assistance to access professional services, such as registered nursing, physical therapy and occupational therapy.

Residents furnish and personalize their suite with their own belongings. Residents pay an accommodation fee, which includes three meals plus snacks, housekeeping and linen

service, and Good Samaritan TeleCare® (an emergency response service).

Optional services include:

- personal laundry service
- cable
- parking

Dementia Care Cottages

There are four-10 bed and three-12 bed cottages at Good Samaritan Park Meadows Village. Our Dementia Care Cottages are unique duplexes designed to create a home-like setting for clients with dementia. Each side of the 10-bed duplexes has five bedrooms and each side of the 12-bed duplexes has six bedrooms. Included in each side of the cottages is a living room with fireplace, kitchen and secure access to the fenced yard. Clients are included in the events of daily living to the extent that they are accustomed and able.

Admission

Admissions are coordinated through the Regional Access Centre, phone 403-388-6380.

Pre-Admission Visits

We encourage all prospective residents and their immediate family members to visit our facilities prior to admission. Appointments for a tour prior to admission are encouraged and may be made by calling 403-328-9404 ext 2260. The visit allows for an exchange of information and discussions regarding expectations on the part of the resident and the care facility.
