## Long Term Care

Good Samaritan Southgate Care Centre consists of 186 semi-private and 39 private, Long Term Care beds. The Good Samaritan Society will provide a hospital style bed and bedside table. Residents are encouraged to bring some of their own belongings such as a small chair, lamp, pictures, quilt or bedspread to personalize their room.

Along with spacious television lounges on every unit, Good Samaritan Southgate Care Centre has a large auditorium for entertainment, worship services and large functions. A quaint chapel is also available for resident, family, visitor and staff use. For the spring and summer months there is a beautiful enclosed yard, with gazebo and shaded patio areas, where residents and visitors can gather.

Services offered include Rehabilitation, Pastoral Care, Social Work and Volunteer Services. Good Samaritan Southgate Care Centre offers an extensive range of recreation programs throughout the week including scheduled outings.

We are located close to bus routes, shopping centres, and medical/health services.

## Admission

All admissions are coordinated through Alberta Health Services (AHS). To qualify for admission into Long Term Care, residents are first assessed by AHS. Please contact AHS at 780-496-1300 for information.

## Pre-Admission Visits

We encourage all prospective residents and their immediate family members to visit Good Samaritan Southgate Care Centre prior to admission.
