Supportive Living

Good Samaritan Spruce Grove Centre offers a total of 30 private Supportive Living studio suites. The Supportive Living program promotes privacy, dignity, independence, individuality, and freedom of choice.

Residents furnish and personalize their suite with their own belongings. Residents pay an accommodation fee, which includes a lunch meal, weekly housekeeping and linen service, basic cable and Good Samaritan TeleCare® (a 24-hour emergency response service).

Optional services include:

- breakfast and supper
- personal laundry

The program offers residents 24-hour on-site personal care, with support of a professional nurse.

Admission

To qualify for admission into Supportive Living, residents are first assessed by Alberta Health Services (AHS). Contact AHS at 780-496-1300.

Pre-Admission Visits

Once assessed as requiring a supportive living level of care, we encourage all prospective residents and their immediate family members to visit Good Samaritan Spruce Grove Centre prior to admission. The visit allows for an exchange of information and discussions regarding expectations on the part of the resident, family and the staff at the care facility. Appointments for a tour prior to admission are encouraged and may be made by calling 780-962-3499.
