## Complex Care

Good Samaritan Wexford Creek includes 80 private Complex Care rooms in a two-storey building. Each room is equipped with a bathroom and wheelchair accessible shower. The Good Samaritan Society will provide a hospital-style bed, night table, dresser and side chair. Residents are encouraged to bring some of their own belongings, such as a chair, lamp, pictures, quilt and/or bedspread to personalize their room.

The Complex Care program is intended for residents that can no longer be supported independently in the community and require 24-hour professional care.

Assessments are coordinated through Home and Community Care, Vancouver Island Health Authority 250-755-6229.

## Dementia Care Cottages

These cottages provide the homelike environment that is suitable for residents with Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia, and for residents that require more medical or physical assistance.

The program for 30 residents is housed in the buildings located in a very unique courtyard setting that has all the appearances of a community neighborhood. The cottages are similar to a duplex. Each duplex has 10 bedrooms, a kitchen, dining room, two living rooms with a fireplace, secure access to a fenced courtyard, and bathing and laundry rooms. The residents are encouraged to furnish their own room with "home" furnishings.

## Independent /Assisted Living

There are 40 private pay Independent and Assisted Living suites. For more information, please call: 250-713-1696.
