Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Clearwater Centre,

Since my last letter to you on October 8 regarding the COVID-19 outbreak at Good Samaritan Clearwater Centre, we have identified 3 additional resident case. Currently we have 3 active resident case, 9 residents and 9 employees have recovered. In consultation with public health, we have completed another round of asymptomatic testing on October 14 of our residents in long term care. We continue to work closely with public health regarding this outbreak and all safety precautions will remain in place at this time.

As a reminder, if there are residents that have not been immunized and would like to be, please connect with site management. The best defense against COVID-19 continues to be immunization and we strongly encourage you to get vaccinated as well if you have not already done so.
