Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Clearwater Centre,

Further to the letter sent to you on October 21, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the COVID-19 outbreak at Good Samaritan Clearwater Centre. No additional cases of COVID-19 have been identified at this time. Currently, we have no active cases and 12 residents and 11 employees have recovered.

Although this is great news, we must all remain vigilant and follow safety precautions that are in place at the care home. While COVID-19 cases in the community are trending in the right direction, we have seen an increase in cases of unknown exposure. As a result, it is important that you follow public health restrictions and guidance out in the community to protect not only yourself but our residents from exposure. This includes continuous masking within our care home when you are visiting.
