We continue to work closely with public health officials and all safety measures in place will remain for the duration of the outbreak. The best defense against COVID-19 continues to be immunization and as the COVID-19 activity continues in our communities, I encourage you to get vaccinated if you have not already done so. Furthermore, with influenza season approaching, it is important that we protect those in our care and therefore please consider getting your flu vaccine.
