Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Garden Vista,

Further to my last letter to you on October 5 regarding the COVID-19 outbreak at Good Samaritan Garden Vista, I wanted to provide you with an update. Through asymptomatic testing, we have identified additional cases of COVID-19. Currently we have 6 active resident and 2 employee cases. We continue to work closely with public health officials and all safety measures in place will remain for the duration of the outbreak.

I know this is not the news that you wanted to hear and I understand how stressful this might be for you. As previously indicated, this exposure does not mean that your family member is sick with COVID-19 and I can assure you that we are closely monitoring all of our residents. Furthermore, residents that are not fully vaccinated have been put on contact/droplet precautions.

The COVID-19 activity has not slowed down in our communities and it continues to affect all of us. If you are out in the community, we encourage you to follow all public health guidelines and restrictions.
