Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Linden View,

Further to my last letter to you on October 15, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the COVID-19 outbreak at Good Samaritan Linden View. We continue to trend in the right direction and no additional resident cases of COVID-19 have been identified at this time. However, we have 1 additional employee case. Out of an abundance of caution, asymptomatic testing was completed today on all residents on second floor and in cottage 1. We have not received any further direction from public health at this time and all restrictions currently in place will remain until the outbreak is declared over.

As announced by the Alberta Chief Medical Officer of Health earlier this week, effective October 25, 2021 all visitors to the care home will be required to continuously wear a mask in all areas. A letter containing all the details has been circulated to all residents and families. Although social visits are discouraged at this time, we ask that you share the information with others that may want to visit our care home. Furthermore, with influenza season approaching, it is important that we protect those in our care and therefore please consider getting your flu vaccine.
