Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Park Meadows Village,

Further to my last letter to you on October 1, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the COVID-19 outbreak at Good Samaritan Park Meadows Village. No new cases of COVID-19 have been identified in the main building and therefore public health has declared the outbreak in the main building over. Out of an abundance of caution, cottage 5 and 7 remain on outbreak status. Currently, we have no active cases and 8 residents and 2 employees have recovered.

All safety precautions currently in place will remain in place within cottage 5 and 7 until public health has declared the outbreak to be over.

As previously indicated, the COVID-19 activity continues to rise in our surrounding communities and therefore it is important that you follow all public health guidelines and restrictions to ensure the safety of our residents, families and employees. This includes continuously masked for the duration of your visit inside our care home, in all areas.
