Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Village by the Station,

Further to the letter sent to you on October 28, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the outbreak at Good Samaritan Village by the Station. Since our last communication we have not identified any additional cases of COVID-19. Currently we have no active cases, 22 residents and 15 employees have recovered. Although, we are trending in the right direction, it is important that we all remain diligent and continue to follow the safety precautions in place.

As a reminder, when off outbreak, as per the updated visitor requirements from the Provincial Health Officer and Ministry of Health, effective October 26, all visitors must show proof of being fully immunized (2 doses of an approved COVID-19 vaccine). Therefore if you plan on visiting, please ensure you have your BC vaccine card and government issued identification readily available for the screener at the entrance to the care home.
