Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Village by the Station,

I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the outbreak at Good Samaritan Village by the Station. Since my last letter to you on October 6, we have identified 3 more resident and 1 employee case. Currently we have 3 active resident and 8 employee cases, 12 residents and 7 employees have recovered. As previously mentioned, the assisted living program is not included in the outbreak. All safety precautions will continue until the outbreak is declared over by public health.

We must continue to remain vigilant and follow all public health restrictions to ensure the safety of our residents, families and staff. This includes continuous masking at all times while you are visiting the care home. As a reminder, as per the updated visitor requirements from the Provincial Health Officer and Ministry of Health, effective October 12, all visitors must show proof of being partially or fully vaccinated prior to entry into the care home. Please remember that social visits are on hold at this time within the long term care program.
