Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Village by the Station,

Further to my last communication to you on September 29, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the outbreak at Good Samaritan Village by the Station. As a reminder, this does not include the assisted living program. Currently we have 12 active resident and 14 employee cases, and 1 employee has since recovered. Sadly, I must report that since our last communication 3 of our residents have passed away as a result of COVID-19. On behalf of the entire organization, our sincerest condolences go out to all of the families and friends that are grieving the loss of their loved one. COVID-19 continues to affect the lives of everyone.

We continue to work very closely with public health officials and all of the safety precautions currently in place will remain for the duration of the outbreak or as advised by public health. I can assure you that our employees continue to remain diligent and are following all measures that are currently in place. Furthermore, residents are being closely monitored for symptoms and employees are continually reminded to self-monitor before, during and after their shift.
