Further to our last communication to you, I would like to provide an update to you regarding the Lee Crest COVID-19 outbreak. Currently we have 4 active resident cases and 3 active staff cases. We have had 4 residents and 6 staff recover. Sadly, I report that one resident passed away from COVID-19 since our last letter. Each resident is a member of our care home community and we extend most sincere condolences to family and friends.

GSS continues to work closely with public health and all precautions remain in place.

For those that are unable to come into to have a social visit, please remind your friends and family that virtual visits can still be arranged by contacting the care home, or visit our website (www.gss.org) and use our Well Wishes tool to send a message or photos to any resident in our care. We know how difficult it is to be away from family and we look forward to the time that social visits can resume.

The southern Alberta communities are seeing continued increases of COVID-19 cases. Immunization protects yourself and others and helps to prevent severe illness and hospitalization.
