Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Lee Crest,

Further to our last communication to you, there has been a change to visitor restrictions at Good Samaritan Lee Crest. Given the newly diagnosed cases of COVID-19 at our care home, public health has implemented the following measures:

- A maximum of (4) four designated support people will be allowed per resident, with maximum of (2) two designated support people visiting at one time per resident.
- All support people must complete daily health screening prior to entering Lee Crest. This includes complete hand hygiene and continuous masking throughout the care home.
- Designated support people are to visit their loved one only. For the safety of all residents and staff we ask that you not roam around hallways or to other parts of Lee Crest.

We will be utilizing the list that included up to 4 designated support people identified by the resident/legal representative prior to the lifting of visitation restrictions in Alberta. If the resident/legal representative would like to update the designated support people on file we request that you please contact Angela Henke, Site Manager.

GSS continues working with staff and public health officials at Lee Crest to identify anyone who may have been exposed and to take steps to protect the health of all residents, families and staff. All previously mentioned restrictions in our last correspondence will remain in effect until further notice.

I would like to remind you once again that virtual visits can still be arranged by contacting the care home, or visit our website ([www.gss.org](http://www.gss.org)) and use our Well Wishes tool to send a message or photos to any resident in our care.

As COVID-19 cases continue to rise in the community, we would like to encourage everyone eligible to get immunized against COVID-19 as soon as possible. If you wish to be immunized and you are a resident, please reach out to your site manager for details on how to have this completed.
