Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan South Ridge Village,

Further to the last letter sent to you on October 22, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the outbreak at Good Samaritan South Ridge Village. Currently we have 3 active resident and 2 employee cases, 24 residents and 21 employees have recovered. Sadly, I must report that 2 additional residents have passed away in the past week as a result of COVID-19 complications. On behalf of the entire organization, I extend our deepest sympathies to the family and friends of these residents. Our thoughts and prayers are with all of you in this time of grief.

I know that this is difficult news to hear and I understand how stressful this might be for you. We are however trending in the right direction and our active cases continue to decline. We completed another round of prevalence testing among our residents on October 25 and thus far the majority have come back as negative with some results still pending.

We continue to work closely with public health regarding this outbreak and our Infection Prevention and Control Team is closely monitoring the situation.
