Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan South Ridge Village,

Further to my last letter on September 30, I wanted to provide you with an update regarding the COVID-19 outbreak at Good Samaritan South Ridge Village. Currently we have 11 active resident and 6 employee cases all of which are on the north wing on second floor. As no new cases of COVID-19 had been identified in the last 14 days on the east wing on second floor, public health has declared the outbreak to be over on that unit only and restrictions are being lifted.

We continue to work closely with public health officials and all precautionary measures will remain in place on the north wing on second floor for the duration of the outbreak. In addition, out of an abundance of caution, and as per the guidance of public health, residents that are not fully vaccinated have been placed on contact/droplet precautions and must remain in their room. Asymptomatic and symptomatic testing was completed once again on October 3 and 4.

As per the direction of the Medical Officer of Health visitors on the north wing unit on second floor are limited to 2 designated persons only and only 1 person in the resident room at any given time. Visitors must be continuously masked during their visits. End of life/palliative care visits can continue.
