Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Wedman Village,

We have been informed that a visitor of a resident in home 1601 has tested positive for COVID-19. Public health has advised that 1601 will be placed on enhanced surveillance. Under the direction of public health, GSS has put additional precautionary measures in place to ensure that residents, families and staff are protected. These include:

- Heightened resident screening twice per day.
- Enhanced cleaning within the home.
- Staff currently working in 1601 will be cohorted to home 1601 only for the time being and rapid testing of staff will continue.

The health and safety of residents, families and staff is our first priority and a responsibility we take very seriously. Should there be any further updates, we will provide these to you as we receive them.

I would like to remind you once again that virtual visits can still be arranged by contacting the care home, or visit our website (www.gss.org) and use our Well Wishes tool to send a message or photos to any resident in our care.
