

LTCF COVID-19 VISITOR ASSESSMENT FORM

Date: May 15, 2020

ALL VISITORS TO LONG-TERM (LTC) CARE FACILITIES MUST BE SCREENED PRIOR TO THEIR VISIT.

1. Take temperature of each visitor prior to entering the LTC facility:
 - (a) If **37.9 degrees C or LESS**, proceed to question # 2.
 - (b) If **38.0 degrees C or ABOVE**, send visitor wearing a mask to a Covid-19 testing site immediately, or as soon as site opens.
 - Provide list of site locations and hours.
 - Ensure visitors wear a mask when attending a testing site.
 - Visitor to self-isolate at home pending results.

2. Ask if visitor is experiencing any of the following symptoms (**new or worsening**):
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Loss of taste/smell
 - (a) If **YES to any of these symptoms**, send visitor with a mask to attend a testing site immediately, or as soon as site opens.
 - Provide list of site locations and hours.
 - Ensure visitor wears a mask when attending a testing site.
 - Visitors to self-isolate at home pending results.
 - (b) If **NO** to fever, cough and diarrhea, proceed to *question # 3*.

3. Ask if visitor is experiencing any of the following milder symptoms (**new or worsening**):

<input type="checkbox"/> Sore throat	<input type="checkbox"/> Muscle ache/fatigue
<input type="checkbox"/> Headache	<input type="checkbox"/> Other symptoms of a cold e.g. congestion

 - (a) If **YES to any of these symptoms**, they should be directed to stay home until they are well or attend a testing site. Do not proceed with planned visit.
 - If the visitor opts to go for testing, ensure they mask.
 - Visitors to self-isolate at home pending test results.
 - Visitors with a previous negative test since their onset of symptoms may proceed with a visit if they had a negative test and their symptoms are stable or resolving.
 - (b) If **NO** proceed with planned visit.
