Dear residents and loved ones of Good Samaritan Delta View Care Centre,

Further to our last communication sent to you on March 22, 2020, I wanted to provide you with an update on our situation at the care home. I am happy to report that all tests completed for unwell residents/employees have come back negative for COVID-19, and we have now been advised that the outbreak is declared over.

Despite this good news, we will continue to ensure additional precautions are in place to protect both our residents and our employees. This includes, but is not limited to, only allowing essential visitors (people visiting those who are actively dying), screening of employees and residents, enhanced cleaning, and physical distancing during all recreation activities.

While I am sure you are relieved that the outbreak status of our care home has been lifted, I do have to emphasize that the Provincial Medical Officer of Health's directive is very stringent, for a good reason, so it is very likely that we may be going through this process again if any employees or residents become unwell. Regardless, we will continue to reach out and to communicate with you every step of the way.
