Dear individuals and loved ones of Good Samaritan Westpark Home,

As you know, testing for COVID-19 was conducted on affected employees and individuals living at the home. Today, Public Health informed us that two individuals have tested positive for COVID-19. One has mild symptoms, and one does not have any symptoms. A third individual has had a negative test result, and we are still waiting on the results for the fourth person who lives at the home. As I notified you on Monday, we have had one employee who has tested positive. All employees who work at the group home have now been tested, and we are awaiting those results.

I want to assure you again that we are complying with all of the orders from the Chief Medical Officer of Health and are working closely with Alberta Health Services and Public Health to take the necessary steps to protect those we care for and our employees. Outbreak protocols are in place which includes redirecting individuals to self-isolate in their bedrooms where possible, employees wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), cancelling group activities or non-essential services and continuing our enhanced cleaning protocols.
