Dear residents and loved ones of Good Samaritan Village by the Station,

As of today, our current case numbers at the care home are as follows:

- Two active resident COVID-19 cases on the second floor.
- Two active employee COVID-19 cases.

All of the outbreak protocols I outlined in my last communication to you continue to be in place, and I want to assure you that we are working closely with Interior Health, and are complying with the orders from the Medical Health Officer to take the necessary steps to protect the residents and employees at the care home.

We continue to monitor all residents and employees closely and are conducting in-depth screenings twice a day, including temperature checks. As well, all second floor long term care residents continue to be on contact droplet precautions, which means residents are isolated in their rooms, and employees wear additional personal protective equipment (masks, face shields, gowns and gloves). They will also be changing personal protective equipment between rooms.

As a friendly reminder, visitation is now limited to compassionate care reasons only (e.g. end-of-life). I would encourage you to reach out to the care home if you would like to arrange a virtual visit, or you can send messages and photos to any resident in our care by visiting [www.gss.org/well-wishes](http://www.gss.org/well-wishes).
