Dear residents and loved ones of Good Samaritan Good Shepherd Home,

I am happy to report that since my last update to you, we have had no additional COVID-19 cases at our care home. We currently have two active COVID-19 employee cases. Despite this, outbreak protocols remain in place and we continue to work closely with Alberta Health Services (AHS) to manage this outbreak.

Asymptomatic testing for residents and employees was completed today, and all rapid results have come back negative. Of course, the results are then sent to the Provincial lab to be verified, and we expect those results by Friday. I can assure you that should any resident test positive, we will let their primary contact or legal health representative know right away.


Residents also successfully received their Moderna Vaccines on January 9. The next dose will be scheduled by AHS, and we do not have a date yet as they are prioritizing first doses to high risk populations before they schedule the second doses.

Social visits continue to be on hold. However, designated family and support visitors are allowed to visit if their presence is deemed essential to the resident's well-being. If you are a designated visitor and must visit in person, please call the care home to schedule your visit in advance so we can continue to limit the number of people in the building at one time. Compassionate care visits (e.g. end-of-life) will continue as normal.
