Dear residents and loved ones of Good Samaritan Delta View Care Centre,

Since my last letter on January 5, 2021, I wanted to provide you with the following updates as it relates to the COVID-19 outbreak

- There is one active resident case on Baycrest (front building).
- To date, there have been thirteen residents who have recovered from COVID-19.
- Sadly, twelve residents have passed away.
- Thirty-eight employees have recovered.

Due to the new resident case on Baycrest, asymptomatic swabbing was completed for residents and employees, and so far all tests have come back negative. Should any resident test positive, we will contact their primary contact or legal health representative right away.

I am also happy to report that COVID-19 vaccinations were administered this past weekend, and over 200 residents, employees and essential visitors were immunized. I know that some essential visitors were not able to get vaccinated on the first day, but I want to thank you for your patience. Vaccinations continued today. Those who are vaccinated will continue to be required to follow all public health measures in place, including wearing personal protective equipment as appropriate and passing the screening.

Fraser Health has notified us that the outbreak for the back building (Delta View Habilitation Centre) has now been declared over, which is wonderful news. While social visits can resume in this building, I need to remind you that only one designated family member or friend may visit. All visitors must wear a mask, clean hands before and after visiting (using soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer) and maintain a distance of two metres from others. Social visitors must also schedule their visit in advance with the care home and socialize in the designated visiting areas. Essential visits will continue as normal.

Please note that the outbreak status for the front building (Delta View Enrichment Centre) is still in place. All outbreak protocols and visitation restrictions continue to be in place for the front building. Please continue to reach out to the care home to arrange virtual visits or use our website (www.gss.org/well-wishes) to send messages or photos to any resident in our care.
