Dear residents and loved ones of Good Samaritan George Hennig Place,

Since my last letter to you on April 15, 2021, I would like to notify you that we still only have one active resident COVID-19 case. This is positive news as it shows we have been able to limit the spread of the virus so far. We continue to follow all public health orders, and the outbreak protocols I highlighted in my communication to you last week remain in place.

Asymptomatic swabbing for residents and employees was conducted today, and results are pending. I can assure you, should any resident test positive, both they and their primary contact or legal health representative will be contacted right away.

As social visits remain on hold, I encourage you to reach out to the care home to arrange virtual visits or visit [www.gss.org/well-wishes](http://www.gss.org/well-wishes) to share photos and messages with those in our care. We are also asking all designated family and support visitors to please limit their visits to the care home unless deemed essential to the resident's well-being. Compassionate care visits (e.g. end-of-life) will continue as normal
