Dear residents and loved ones of Good Samaritan Lee Crest,

I wanted to provide you with an update on our current COVID-19 outbreak. At this time, we have no additional COVID-19 cases, and two of our employees who had COVID-19 have now recovered and one is still considered an active case. I want to assure you that we continue to follow all of the public health orders that have been put in place by Alberta Health Services and the Medical Officer of Health.

As I mentioned in my update last week, at the direction of the Medical Officer of Health, we had to place several residents on contact and droplet precautions. We know this is not easy for anyone currently isolating, but we want to thank you for your patience and understanding as we work through this together.

Asymptomatic testing was completed today, and should any resident test positive, their primary contact or legal health representative will be notified right away.

At this time, all social visits remain on hold. We are also asking all designated family and support visitors to please limit their visits to the care home whenever possible unless deemed essential to the resident's well-being. Compassionate care visits (e.g. end-of-life) will continue as normal. I would strongly encourage you to reach out to the care home to arrange virtual visits or visit [www.gss.org/well-wishes](http://www.gss.org/well-wishes) to share photos and messages with those in our care.
