Dear Residents and Loved Ones of Good Samaritan Pembina Village,

Further to our last communication sent to you, I want to provide you with an update on the outbreak at Good Samaritan Pembina Village. I am happy to report that no additional cases of COVID-19 have been identified, however, our care home continues to be placed on outbreak status. We will continue to keep in place the following public health recommendations:

- Symptomatic testing of residents will continue.
- There are no restrictions on visitation at this time. However, PPE is required at all times.
- High-risk recreational activities are discouraged but group activities may continue if the proper safety protocols are followed (social distancing, hand hygiene and use of PPE).
- Enhanced environmental cleaning to continue.
- Staff will continue to cohort as much as possible.

As we see case numbers continuing to rise across the province, I would like to remind you that virtual visits can still be arranged by contacting the care home, or visit our website (www.gss.org) and use our Well Wishes tool to send a message or photos to any resident in our care.

We appreciate your assistance in helping to keep all of our residents and employees safe.

Finally, I would like to sincerely thank all of our residents, their loved ones, and our employees for their patience and assistance as we've managed this most recent outbreak. It is truly a team effort, and we are very appreciative to everyone involved.
